Refugee Resettlement: A New Ministry for a New Beginning

Refugees are those who have been forced to flee their home country because of persecution, war, or violence. Refugees status is granted only by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees; Resettlement into the USA occurs only after further extensive screening. The EUMC Refugee Resettlement Ministry Team, in partnership with Lutheran Community Services NW, is a new ministry to promote the successful integration of a refugee family into our local community. The US State Department has set out specific requirements for household items refugee families need to start up their new life. We anticipate our family's arrival in May.
