The US State Department has set out detailed requirements for household items that our team must provide for refugee families to start up their new life.

For those who would like to help, here are 2 ways to provide those specific items:

1) the EUMC Amazon smile account. Go to: Amazon.com. Go to: Account and Lists. Select: "Find a List or Registry." In search box, enter: "Refugee Resettlement Team." The Shopping List will come up. For every item purchased, Amazon donates a percentage to EUMC, and the item will go off the registry list.

2) a check written to EUMC with "Refugee Resettlement Ministry" in the memo.
