Youth Leader

This is a part time position and reports to the Director for Children and Family Ministries.

The Youth Leader, as a team member, draws our church community closer to provide creative, intergenerational, learning, and fun opportunities for our youth. The youth leader must be passionate about embracing anti -racist practices, centering LGBTQIA+, and differently abled youth as they work with the worship team, and the congregation to meet the spiritual needs of the youth and grow disciples in Christ.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Leadership

- Lead 2 youth groups (middle school, 3-5pm; high school, 6-8pm on Sundays)
- Attend and connect with youth during Sunday morning worship
- Encourage youth leadership and participation in weekly worship services
- Serve as an advocate for Youth Ministry with staff, congregation, and lay leaders

Programming

- Design and develop weekly youth programs and occasional retreats, day trips and weeklong camps for youth
- Develop & implement new programs to enhance and grow the youth ministry and help stakeholders grow in their relationships with each other and Jesus Christ
- Equip families with resources and education to help them become actively and intentionally involved in the spiritual formation of their youth
- Work with the Director of Family Ministries to coordinate church-wide activities

Administration

- Manage communications with Youth and Families using a variety of technology and social media
- Ensure EUMC Safe Church Policy is followed and enforced, including completion of appropriate training, background checks, and paperwork
- Collaborate with Director of Family Ministries to develop budget for youth ministries

Other

- Serve as a healthy and accessible role model by establishing work boundaries and time off
- Provide support for youth and families; alert the Director and Pastor to specific needs
- Network with community organizations to develop partnership opportunities
- Participate in Church staff meetings as asked and partner in broader Church projects as appropriate

- Experience in a leadership role in youth programming
- Able to build positive and constructive relationships with youth and their parents

- Proven planning, organization, and problem-solving skills

- Approachable, open-minded, flexible, and adaptable
