

Types of Senior Housing

Independent - 55 + or 62 +

- Completely independent apartments with no services, may have amenities and activities for residents included in rent or for an additional fee
- Independent apartments with communal dining and activities included in rent
- Independent apartments within in an Independent Living/Assisted Living community

Assisted Living

• Typically communities of 40 to 100, or more, apartments with amenities and services. Rent includes 3 meals daily, activities, transportation to doctor's appointments and shopping, weekly outings to museums, sporting events, etc., utilities, housekeeping, fitness classes, educational events and more. Communities have onsite wellness offices with nurses and often have visiting physicians. Care is provided when needed to support activities of daily living which include bathing, dressing, eating, toileting and medication management. Prices are dependent on level of care needed.

Memory Care

- Many of the same attributes of Assisted Living, in a secure community, for those who are not safe on their own behind closed doors, or those that may be at risk for getting injured or lost if they are not in a secure location.
- Memory Care may be a section or floor within an Assisted Living community, or it may be the entire community dedicated solely to caring for those with various forms of dementia, including Alzheimer's Disease.

Adult Family Homes

• Washington State licenses Adult Family Homes for a maximum of 6-8 residents being cared for in a home residence with 24-hour onsite caregivers. Owners may be registered nurses, or they may have contracted nurses provide nurse delegation for tasks that require it. Assistance is provided for all care needs for a set price each month based on an assessment done before move in. Homes provide activities that are tailored to individual needs. Adult Family Homes cater to those with, and without, dementia, those with high care needs but who don't need to be in skilled nursing facilities, and those who prefer a home setting.




